Activity 1: Fun Guessing Game: Guess that Picture!

Activity 2: Rhythm Practice

Time to practice clapping and saying rhythms.

Ta= Quarter note (1 beat)

Ti-ti= Eighth note (1 beat)

To-e= Half note (2 beats) *hold one clap for 2 beats

SHH or Rest= Q ter rest (1 silent beat)

Steps:


- 1. Click here
- 2. Follow the video and say the rhythm aloud Ex. "ta, ta, ti-ti, ta"
- 3. Watch the 3-4 times. Say and clap the rhythms.
- 4. If you would like a challenge, <u>click here</u> to move on to the bonus level and you will practice clapping 2 four beat measures together (8 beats in a row).

Activity 3: Creative Cloud watching

Steps

- 1. On a cloudy day, I encourage you to take a blanket outside and lay on your grass, deck, porch or just gaze out of a window up at the sky.
- 2. When you are looking at the clouds, you should have an open mind. Try not to think of something you might see before hand, just let the images appear.
- 3. Take a picture of the clouds when you see an image, and try to recreate or draw that image on another piece of paper. The sky is the limit (literally!).


